WHAT

The Australia's Green Cauldron is one of Australia's 16 National Landscapes – a unique partnership between Tourism Australia and Parks Australia to identify the best places to experience Australia's outstanding nature and culture.

Stretching from Byron Bay to the Great Coast and well towards the Great Dividing Range, it's one of the few places in Australia where tourism leads to the ocean.

The region is home to 12 National Parks – including the Border Ranges National Park to the west, Lamington and Springbrook National Parks to the north, with Wollemi National Park in the centre. There are also the Gondwanan Rainforests of Australia World Heritage Area – the southern hemisphere's largest extinct shore volcano.



lions road

rainforest way

Originally an unsealed track between Kyogle and Besenbent this toll road was built by the Lions Clubs of these towns in 1971. Now fully sealed, this is a very scenic drive following the Borderline rail line and Running Creek (CR) and Grudge Creek (GRW).

The link section commences north of Mt Lion in NSW and from north of Mt Chinghee in Queensland. This section is not suitable for Camaros and there is a height limit for the numerous rail bridges and at the state border. Travelling north from Kyogle the Lions Road turns off a Star north of Wangapean. Travelling south from Besenbent turn left at Rathdowney into Running Creek Road.

Complete the loop and wind through the forests surrounding Mt Lindalup on the Summerland Way.

things to do along the way

- Pick up a copy of the history of the Lions Road at the Kyogle or Rathdowney Visitor Information Centres.
- View the rail engineering feat of the Border Loop as it spirals through the mountain.
- Do the nature walk at the Border Loop Lookout.
- Call into one of the roadside Cafe or General Stores for a cool drink and a chat with a local.
- Check out the displays at the Rathdowney Museum and Information Centre.
- Look out for the inspiring wedding cake view of Mount Lindalup.
- Visit Mt Barney National Park whose rugged peaks are amongst the most spectacular in South-East Queensland.
